SCHOOL POLICY

- Pupil with diagnosed learning disorder
- →Intake in august with pupil and parent(s)
- →Individual action plan for 1 year
- → Renewal every year (different age = different needs)

ACTION PLAN DYSCALCULIA

- Pupil can choose to use following measures:
- →Extended time for assignments / exam
- →Oral exams instead of written ones
- →Extra explanation about the questions asked in exams
- → Teacher verifies if the questions are interpreted correctly
- → Use of extra resources (calculator/laptop)
- → Dispensation of doing math-exercises in front of the whole class

BACKGROUND ELLA

- First grade SE → other school
- Only then diagnosed ADD + dyscalculia
- December third year SE: major problems for mathematics
 - → re-orientated
- January third year → Hemaco Dendermonde
- Brother Vic (ASD + ADHD) in first year of our school

SECOND GRADE

Ella works hard and has excellent marks for languages, human sciences, history ...

Problems with mathematics and science sustained.

- → Measures:
- Extended time for assignments / tests
- Use of a calculator
- Opportunity to ask for extra help during mathexams
- → Everything went well in second grade

THIRD GRADE

Department social sciences >> minimal curriculum maths and sciences (results for mathematics and science dramatic: 30%)

- → Extra measures were needed:
- she can use her written notes and textbook during tests and exams
- the teacher sometimes gives her the first step (more complex exercises)
- → Marks are better but still not over 50%

FUTURE

Mathematics will always be a problem for Ella (especially in daily life: paying in a store, reading the clock, writing down phone numbers,...)

But at least she can graduate high school and go to college to study something she really likes: foreign languages (Spanish, Russian,...)
